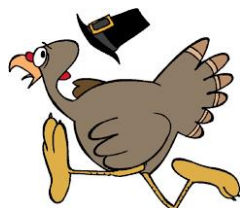

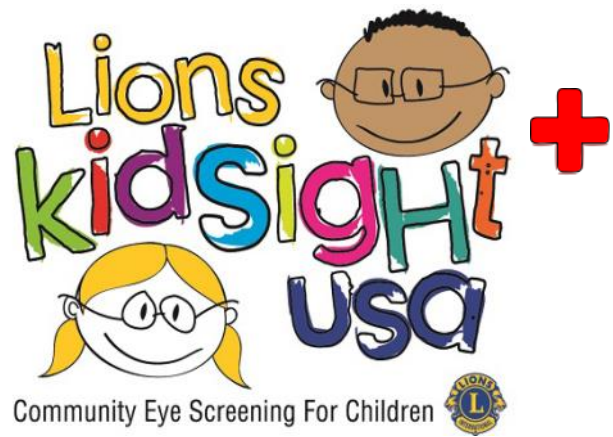

Vision Screening

I just want to tell all of you who have helped. We have worked through three months, sometimes 5 days a week with little time off. As our screening, October 31st, at Due West ES, we surpassed the 10,000 mark for screenings. It's not over yet because we have November to go through and then two schools in December but the hard push is over.

In addition to those screenings, and most important to me, we are seeing an increase in the schools following up with the students that we failed. As of today, we have issued 51 vouchers for eye exams to Cobb County School students and I get requests every week for more assistance. That is why we do this. These numbers are for the Cobb County Schools only and do not include the health fairs that we do.

We have every right to be proud of ourselves because as Lions we are doing a great job and providing a tremendous service to the public.

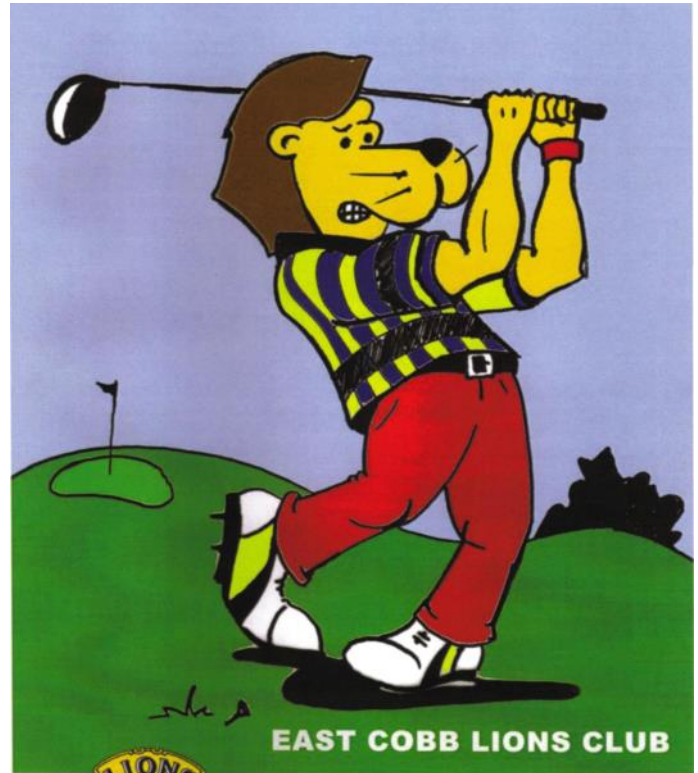

Recycling Eyeglasses

The East Cobb Lions are an integral part of the Lighthouse recycled eyeglass program. We have been involved from collection and cleaning to distribution of the glasses. We have set up collection boxes in offices, schools, churches, and at local eye wear distributor's shops.



The East Cobb Lions Club brings in thousands of eyeglasses each year to the Lighthouse where the usable glasses are cleaned, sorted by type (bifocals, single vision, reading, etc.), and read using a lensometer. They are distributed overseas by groups on mission trips that include optometrists or ophthalmologists that examine needy recipients and match their needs to the proper prescription from the inventory of used eyeglasses.
